## **Today's Scripture**

# Matthew 13: 1-9, 18-23

<sup>1</sup> Later that day, Jesus left the house and sat down by the lake shore. <sup>2</sup> Such great crowds gathered that he went and took a seat in a boat, while the crowd stood along the shore. <sup>3</sup> He addressed them at length in parables: "One day, a farmer went out sowing seed. <sup>4</sup> Some of the seed landed on a footpath, where birds came and ate it up. <sup>5</sup> Some of the seed fell on rocky ground, where there was little soil. This seed sprouted at once since the soil had no depth, <sup>6</sup> but when the sun rose and scorched it, it withered away for lack of roots. <sup>7</sup> Again, some of the seed fell among thorns, and the thorns grew up and choked it. <sup>8</sup> And some of it landed on good soil, and yielded a crop thirty, sixty, even a hundred times what was sown. <sup>9</sup> Let those who have ears to hear, hear this!"

<sup>18</sup> "Now listen to the parable of the sower. <sup>19</sup> When people hear the message about the kindom of God without understanding it, the Evil One comes along and snatches away what was sown in their hearts. This is the seed sown along the path. <sup>20</sup> Those who received the seed that fell on rocky ground are the ones who hear the word and at first welcome it with joy. <sup>21</sup> But they have no roots, so they last only for a while. When some setback or persecution comes because of the message, they quickly fall away. <sup>22</sup> Those who receive the message that fell among the thorns are the ones who hear the word, but then worldly anxieties and the lure of wealth choke it off, and the message produces no fruit. <sup>23</sup> But those who receive the seed that fell on rich soil are those who hear the message and understand it. They produce a crop that yields a hundred, or sixty or thirty times what was sown."
