# **Today's Scripture**

#### Mark 1:14-20

<sup>14</sup> After John's arrest, Jesus appeared in Galilee proclaiming the Good News of God: 15 "This is the time of fulfillment. The reign of God is at hand! Change your hearts and minds, and believe this Good News!" 16 While walking by the Sea of Galilee, Jesus saw the brothers Simon and Andrew casting their nets into the sea, since they fished by trade. <sup>17</sup> Jesus said to them, "Follow me; I will make you fishers of humankind." 18 They immediately abandoned their nets and followed Jesus. <sup>19</sup> Proceeding a little further along, Jesus saw the brothers James and John Bar-Zebedee. They too were in their boat, putting their nets in order. <sup>20</sup> Immediately Jesus called them, and they left their father Zebedee standing in the boat with the hired help, and went off in the company of Jesus.
